- Founded:** 1966
- Size:** 210 acres of fields, forests, and wetlands
- Mission:** The mission of Squam Lakes Natural Science Center is to advance understanding of ecology by exploring New Hampshire's natural world.
- Staff:** 29 full time year-round; 8 part-time, 26 seasonal
- Volunteers:** 248 volunteers giving over 5,273 hours in 2022
- Program Attendance:** Over 24,000 guests served in 2022 through school field trips, special events, and other programs at the Science Center
- Trail Attendance:** More than 63,000 in 2022
- Cruise Passengers:** More than 8,500 in 2022
